MESSAGE FROM THE VICE-PRESIDENT

Assalaamu Alaikum Brothers and Sisters:

Glory be to You Allah: we have no knowledge except what you have taught us. Verily, You are the All-Knower, All-Wise.

We are saddened and highly concerned by a spate of attacks on mosques and Muslims that have occured in recent months across Australia, and we will continue to ask the Australian Federal Police (AFP) for their support to ensure the safety of our community. As you are no doubt aware, the Australian Government is in the process of finalising the Religious Discrimination Act (RDA). In a media release on 30 November, the Prime Minister Scott Morrison demonstrated the Government's committment to protecting religious freedoms by getting the law right before it is brought into effect. We pray to Allah (swt) to safeguards all of us against all the evils and we appreciate all the work the Government is doing to protect the Muslim community in Australia.

The CMC Executive Committee (EC) supports the Australian National Imam's Council's (ANIC) stance on all incidents as a leading Muslim body and will continue to help and work with them in whatever shape or form.

As always, the last couple of months have been busy yet rewarding for the CMC EC, with the main highlights being:

- 1. Meeting with Kuwait Embassy and Qatar Embassy officials to discuss funding opportunities;
- National mosque Open day: Alhumdulilah, on 26 October 2019 we had a 3rd successful Gungahlin mosque open day, where we welcomed individuals (including ACT government officials) of all backgrounds, ethnicities, cultures, and faiths to learn about Islam in a warm and welcoming environment;
- 3. Wudu Area and Classrooms construction work:
 Construction work for wudu area, toilets and
 classrooms is progressing. Although we are behind, we
 are trying our best to complete the Wudu rooms work
 by end of February 2020 with the view to finalising the
 classrooms by Ramadan 2020.
- 4. Youth activities: Alhumdulilah, Imam Hamza organised a youth camp in the beginning of October and recently on 29 November with the help of Br Ibrahim Bangura, Br Khalid and a few other brothers we had a successful youth night at Gungahlin mosque.

On behalf of EC, I would like to express our appreciation for your generous help and continued support for the Gungahlin Mosque as well as various other projects, including the Queanbeyan Mosque, Darwin Mosque, Taqwa school, and the victims of the bushfires across the Eastern parts of Australia.



Wudu area (washrooms) update

- * Design, structure, electrical cabling and plumbing has been completed.
- * Bathroom fixtures and tiles have been ordered and are being installed shortly.
- * We are currently installing a mechanical system.
- * Remaining work includes Gyprock work, installation of bathroom fixtures, tiles and ventilators. Estimated completion is February 2020.

Classrooms

- * Design, structure, and electrical cabling has been completed.
- * Remaining work includes Security and AV cabling, Ducted Vacuum, gyprock, paint, kitchens and cabinets, carpets, AC, doors, awnings and footpath around the classrooms and Ante room.
- * We expect the classrooms to be ready by Ramadhan 2020.



Regarding revisions to the budget and hence the current shortfall, this is due to a number of costs not being identified and accounted for in the original budget


Parking Lights:

National Mosque Open Day Successful Event at Gungahlin Masjid

Hundreds of members of the broader Canberra community visit Gungahlin Masjid to see the Masjid, meet local Muslims, and learn more about Islam.

The National Mosque Open Day was a nation-wide event observed by numerous mosques across the country on Saturday 26th October 2019. This is the third year in a row that Gungahlin Masjid has participated in the event.

Despite less than ideal weather conditions about 400 locals visited our masjid. Prominent visitors included:

ACT Government Minster for Community Services, Disability, Employment and Facilities Ms Suzanne ORR, Michael Pettersson, MLA, Deepak-Raj Gupta, MLA, Alistair Coe, MLA, ACT opposition leader,

Representatives from the Australian Federal Police (AFP); and Local Church leaders and representatives from other religious and cultural organisations.

A number of brothers from the Da'awah Committee were on board also to give lectures and speak to visitors.

The Sisters similarly had people on hand to welcome and speak to visitors and arranged stalls for visitors just

outside the entrance.

Brown Snake Found at Gungalin Masjid



As many of you will already know, in early December a brown snake was found near the entrance of the masjid. A professional snake catcher was called immediately and the snake removed from the masjid, allamdu lillah.

As per the advice from the snake catcher, the snake was likely in the masjid to find food such as rats or mice. With this advice in mind it is absolutely critical that we keep the masjid as

clean as possible at all times, namely to avoid creating more places for rodents or snakes to hide and more importantly to avoid attracting rodents that will in turn attract snakes.

Following the snake visit, a number of volunteers cleaned up the entry area to the masjid and will conduct further cleanups in coming weeks to ensure grass around the masjid is short and unnecessary junk removed.

We have also arranged for a pest controller to come in to treat the masjid.

If you happen to spot a snake in or around the masjid please ensure that you do not get close to the snake but rather call in an expert to catch the snake.

If you have any questions do not hesitate to contact a representative of the exec.


New Look Website


As you may have noticed, the Gunghalin Masjid website has recently been updated with a new look and layout.
